Principal welcomed the members and briefed about the ongoing activities of Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC). The coordinator briefed about the salient points of previous meeting, action taken and agenda of the present meeting to all the members. The following points were discussed in the meeting.

The coordinator briefed about the Tasks proposed in the previous IQAC meeting and the actions completed/under progress.

11.0 Strategic Planning

To achieve academic excellence, it is suggested to continue and strengthen the activities by focusing or giving priority to the criteria such as faculty development, education through cross cultural activities, research & development, Institute-Industry interactions and excellent administrative support.

11.1 Faculty development

- 11.1.1 In addition to the regular training programs, it is suggested
 - a. to organize special training programs for the junior faculties in order to improve their mentoring ability.
 - to organize HR training programs for the entry level faculty members in order to get the expected change in their attitude.
- 11.1.2 To improve the connectivity among departments, members suggested that inter department activities (technical and non technical) may be conducted once in a month through staff club or technical forums.

11.2 Education through cross cultural activities

- 11.2.1 Principal suggested that college level interdisciplinary programs may be organized for students for the improvement of their interdisciplinary knowledge and skills.
- 11.2.2 For enhancing the communication among the students, faculty members and the society, a community radio may be established in our institution.

- 11.2.3 Director requested the HODs of all the departments to give awareness among the students about the choosing of elective subjects.
- 11.2.4 NEC has signed MOU with University of Texas, Dallas, USA. In this connection, the students are requested to apply for summer Internship program of University of Texas for one month during June 2017.
 - In this regard, members suggested to encourage the students, the management may provide a partial funding and the remaining support may be obtained from alumni network (for accommodation and food) for enhancing our International relationship with foreign universities.
 - All the HODs are requested to motivate the students to attend this program and further the director requested the HODs to guide the students for getting funds from funding agencies, alumni network, etc.,
- 11.2.5 It is suggested to provide the information about the day to day activities of college to the students and faculty members through college website, electronic display, email, etc.,

11.3 Research & Development

- 11.3.1 The members suggested that the faculty may be instructed to publish their research articles only in reputed journals with impact factor.
- 11.3.2 The committee suggested that the faculty members may be encouraged to attend very high quality workshops conducted by IITs / NITs to acquire state of the art research findings in their chosen field.
 - The principal informed that the management is already sponsoring the faculty members to attend programmes such as GIAN conducted by various IITs / NITs in collaboration with experts from foreign universities.

11.4 Institute Industry Interaction

- 11.4.1 In order to improve the Industry-Institution relationship, it was suggested to encourage the faculty members to attend industrial training at least for a week or fifteen days in reputed industries.
- 11.4.2 In this regard, the principal informed that a policy has been already taken by the college and informed to the faculty members to attend industrial know how programmes atleast for one week in every two years. The college would meet the expenditure incurred in this regard.

11.5 Administrative Support

- 11.5.1 It is suggested to create college e-mail id for all the students to practice paper less administration with the help of online classes like Google class room.
- 11.5.2 Principal stated that a decision has been taken to facilitate all the class rooms in each department with LED monitors and internet facility.

11.6 Measure of Academic Excellence

- 11.6.1 Director suggested that the academic excellence can be measured using the % of students qualifying the GATE score, IES score and % of students placed in core and software companies at the completion of their graduation.
- 11.6.2 Members suggested that end semester evaluation scheme (like question paper setting) is to be further standardized for improving academic excellence.
- 11.6.3 It is suggested that reexaminations for Internal Assessment Tests may be conducted only under unavoidable circumstances.
- 11.6.4 Principal suggested that excellence may be measured in the college level activities with the help of the appropriate quality indicators and matrices fixed by the strategic planning committee.

Director appreciated all the members of IQAC for their effective involvement in the Brain storming session and their valuable suggestion to improve the quality of education in the college in all the aspects. The coordinator thanked all the IQAC members for their active involvement towards the quality improvement.
