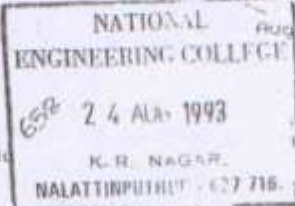

Sub: AICTE approval to the National Engineering College,
Kovilpatti, Tamil Nadu

Sir,

I am directed to state that on the basis of the recommendations of the Expert Committee of the Southern Regional Committee (SRC), the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE) has granted approval to the National Engineering College, Kovilpatti, Tamil Nadu for conduct of the following existing four year Degree courses with the annual intakes indicated against each during the academic year 1993-94 only:-

Mechanical Engineering	60 (Sixty)
Electronics & Communication Engineering	60 (Sixty)
Computer Science & Engineering	60 (Sixty)

This approval is subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-

- 1) The Management should complete the construction immediately conforming to the norms prescribed by AICTE for the instructional area.
- 2) The College should have its own facilities and the sharing of facilities with the Polytechnic should be discontinued immediately.
- 3) Library books and journals should be provided as per the norms of AICTE.
- 4) College should take immediate steps to recruit appropriately qualified senior/middle level teaching staff, such as Professors, Assistant Professors and Lecturers in all the Departments.
- 5) The assets acquired for the College such as Land, Buildings and equipment etc. by the Trust should be transferred to the books of accounts of the College as the College assets.

- 6) AICTE pay scales should be paid to all the teaching faculty with immediate effect.
- 7) The recurring cost per student per year should be brought up to the norms of AICTE i.e. Rs.11,916/-.
- 8) The Management of the College including the Governing Council should be constituted as per the guidelines of the AICTE.
- 9) All admissions should be made as per the norms and guidelines of the AICTE as adopted by the State of Tamil Nadu.
- 10) The tuition and other fees should be charged as prescribed by the State Government within the overall criteria prescribed by the AICTE from time to time. No capitation fees should be charged from the students/ guardians of the students in any form.
- 11) The accounts of the Institute should be audited by a Chartered Accountant and should be open for inspection by the AICTE or anybody authorised by it.
- 12) The teaching and other staff should be recruited according to the procedure, guidelines and experience prescribed by the AICTE.
- 13) No new course should be started without the prior approval of the AICTE.
- 14) The intake in any of the approved courses should not be altered under any circumstances without the prior concurrence of the AICTE.


This approval is subject to full compliance with the provisions of the SCHEME as prescribed by the Supreme Court of India in its Judgment dated 4-2-1993 on Writ Petition (C) No. 607 of 1992.

The Management should strictly follow any further conditions as may be laid down by the AICTE from time to time.

In the event of non-compliance by the Trust or the Institute with the above conditions of the AICTE, the AICTE will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and that all the consequent liabilities would be that of the Trust and/or the Institute.

An Expert Committee of the AICTE will visit the College by the end of the academic year 1993-94 to review the progress made in fulfilling the conditions laid down by the AICTE and recommend continuation of the AICTE approval or otherwise.
