| <p><b>6.0 REGISTRATION</b></p> <p><b>6.4</b> If the theory course in which the student has failed / has been prevented from writing end semester examination due to lack of attendance in a programme elective course or an open elective, then the student may register for the same or any other professional elective or open elective course respectively in the subsequent semesters.</p> | <p><b>6.0 REGISTRATION</b></p> <p><b>6.4</b> If the theory course in which the student has been prevented from writing end semester examination due to lack of attendance in a programme elective course or an open elective, then the student may register for the same or any other professional elective or open elective course respectively in the subsequent semesters during the minimum period of study. However, if the students are unable to complete the courses within the minimum said duration, they shall register their courses in the subsequent academic year irrespective of Odd or Even semester. However, the maximum credits in a semester should not exceed 30.</p> |
| <p><b>6.10 Flexibility to Add or Drop Courses</b></p> <p><b>6.10.2</b> From the third to eighth semester, the student has the option of registering for additional courses or dropping existing courses. Total number of credits of such courses cannot exceed 6. However, the student shall register for a minimum of 16 credits and a maximum of 30 credits in a semester.</p>               | <p><b>6.10 Flexibility to Add or Drop Courses</b></p> <p><b>6.10.2</b> From the third to eighth semester, the student has the option of registering for additional courses or dropping existing courses. However, the student shall register for a <b>minimum of 12 credits</b> and a maximum of 30 credits in a semester.</p>  |

The evaluation will be made based on the report and a viva-voce examination conducted internally by a three member Departmental Committee constituted by the <b>Head of the Department</b>.
