
The surgery time neared. Lily asked the doctor who's going to operate on her to see how God looks while he sees her heart. She was taken into the operation room.

#### **WATER LIFE:**




#### **POLLUTION OF WATER:**


#### **SAVE WATER:**





#### **SOCIAL LIFE**



#### **OUTCOME-BASED EDUCATION (OBE):**


Outcome-based Education is useful to students since it incorporates the needs of the students and ensures placements in good companies. Orientation toOutcome Based Education is given to us.


#### **SPORTS:**

#### **CONCLUSION:**



#### IMPORTANCE OF FREE EDUCATION:


