With a view to take up women's issues and problems, the cell aims at creating awareness of their rights and duties. It also provides a platform for women to share their experiences and views regarding their status in the society. Added to it suggestions for improvement and empowerment among themselves has been given. Aiming at intellectual and social up liftment of the female students, the cell stands for facilitating women's empowerment through guest lectures, seminars, awareness programs and other welfare activities.

A. Safety and Security

- Girl students are periodically counseled on safety and security by faculty mentors.

• Physical Education Trainee strain and motivate both the boys and girls students to participate in various activities related to sports.

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C. Common Rooms



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




Counseling Room-Counsel by the Mentor






