They use the library's physical and e-resources, such as books, journals, e-books, research databases and remote access services, to their full potential and also promote the library's resources and services among students and faculty members through social media.
- 3. Library Innovator Award:** This award recognizes users who introduce innovative ideas or solutions to enhance library services or operations. It includes those who are actively involved in implementing new library initiatives.
- 4. Library Volunteer Award:** This award is given to volunteers who make significant contributions to the library's operations and events. It acknowledges regular volunteer work, exceptional commitment and impactful support.

It is proposed that these awards be implemented starting from the academic year 2024-25 and presented annually. Two candidates will be selected for each award category based on the criteria outlined in Annexure-I, by the Library Award Selection Committee. We seek your approval for this initiative and request permission to proceed with the necessary steps for its implementation.
