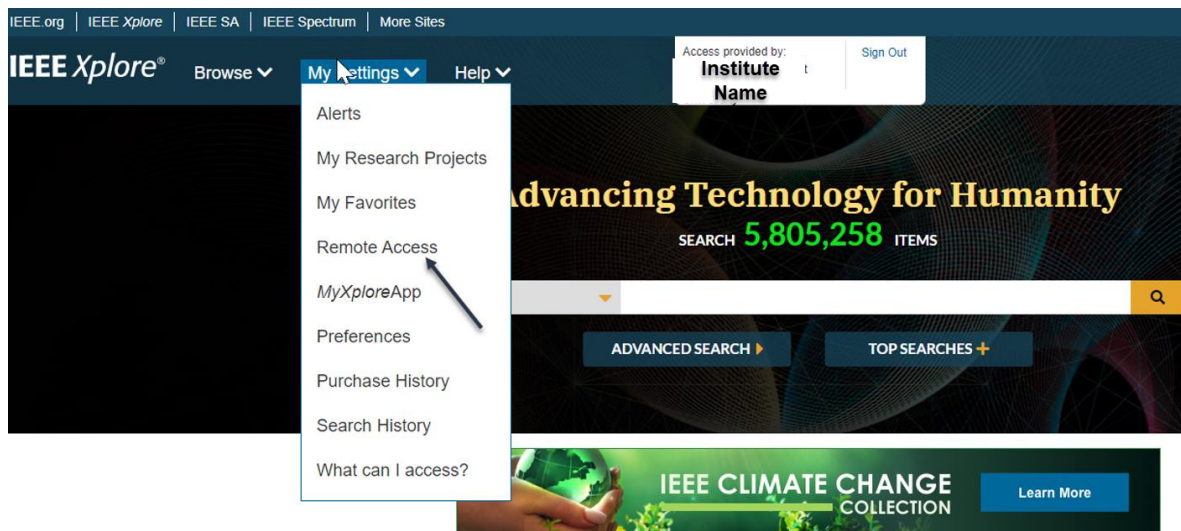


Access IEEE Xplore remotely using *IEEE Remote Access*

IEEE Remote Access is now an option for IP authenticated customers to offer roaming access to users who need to access the institutional IEEE Xplore subscription off-site. Users in participating institutions can use this new feature to access IEEE Xplore content on mobile devices when away from the institution.

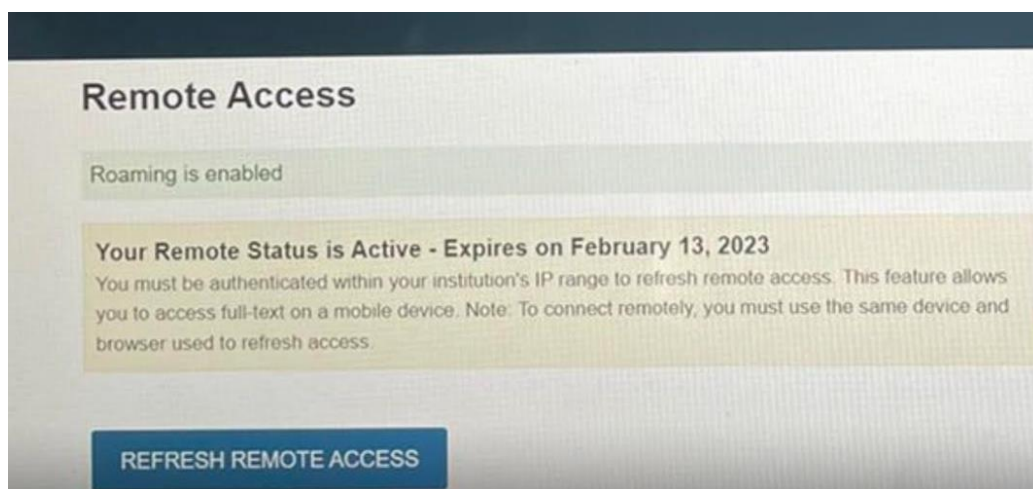
To take advantage of this feature, connect your device to access LAN or institutional IP authenticated WiFi to set up remote access.

Step 1: Visit the IEEE Xplore platform from your device <http://ieeexplore.ieee.org>



Step 2: Create a free personal account by clicking on Create Account on the top right hand side. Login to your personal account.

Step 3: Go to "My Settings", and click on "Remote Access"



Step 4: Follow the instructions to pair your device. Users will be asked to sign in with an IEEE personal account before pairing.

This device can now be used off-site for 90 days to access IEEE Xplore. User must go to IEEE Xplore on the paired device and log in with their personal account to access the roaming subscription.

After 90 days, users will be prompted to again pair their device and can follow the same steps as the initial pairing.

Follow these guidelines to use Remote Access:

- Use the same device used to establish access
- Use the same browser used to establish access
- Sign in with your personal account

Users can set up Remote Access on any number of mobile devices .
